$\bar{K}\text{-}\mathbf{Nuclear}$ Interactions and Dynamics

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Coupled-channel $\bar{K}N$ dynamics near threshold and its repercussions in \bar{K} -nuclear fewbody systems will be briefly reviewed [1], highlighting studies of a K^-pp quasibound state. In heavier nuclei, the extension of mean-field calculations to multi- \bar{K} nuclear and hypernuclear quasibound states will be discussed, concluding that strangeness in self-bound finite systems is realized through hyperons, with no room for kaon condensation [2].
